STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

Appointment of district judges in Uttar Pradesh and a few other have invalid been rendered and illegal by a recent judgment of the Supreme Court on the ground that such appointments were not made accordance with the provisions of article 233 of the Constitution. another judgment, the Supreme Court had held that the power of posting under article 233 include district judge does not the power transfer of such judge from one station to another and that the power transfer of district of a iudge is vested in the High Court under article 235 of the Constitution. As a result of these judgments, has serious situation has arisen because doubt been thrown on the validity of the judgments, decrees. orders and sentences passed or made by these district judges and a number of writ petitions and other have already been filed challenging their validity. The cases functioning of the district courts in Uttar Pradesh has practically come a standstill. It is. therefore, urgently necessary judgments, decrees. orders passed validate the and sentences or made heretofore States by all such district judges in those and also to validate the appointment, posting, promotion and transfer of such district judges barring those few who were not eligible for appointment under article 233.

2. The Bill seeks to give effect to the above proposals.

THE CONSTITUTION (TWENTIETH AMENDMENT) ACT, 1966

[22nd December, 1966.]

An Act further to amend the Constitution of India.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Seventeenth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. Short title.- This Act may be called the Constitution (Twentieth Amendment) Act, 1966.

- 2. Insertion of new article 233A.- After article 233 of the Constitution, the following article shall be inserted, namely:-
- "233A. Validation of appointments of and judments, delivered etc., certain district judes.-Notwithstanding any judgment, decree by, order of any court,-
- (a) (i) no appointment of any person already in the judicial service of a State or of any person who has been for not less than seven years an advocate or a pleader, to be a district judge in that State, and
- (ii) no posting, promotion or transfer of any such person as a district judge,
- time before the commencement the Constitution made at any of(Twentieth Amendment) Act, 1966, otherwise than in accordance with provisions of article 233 or article 235 shall be deemed to be illegal or void or ever to have become illegal or void by reason only of that such appointment, posting, transfer fact promotion or was not made in accordance with the said provisions;
- exercised, iurisdiction no judgment, decree, sentence or order and no other act or proceeding done or taken, passed or made, before the commencement of THE CONSTITUTION (Twentieth Amendment) Act, 1966 before. any person appointed, posted, promoted transferred State otherwise than in district judge in any accordance with article 223 or article 235 shall be deemed to be illegal provisions of or invalid or ever to have become illegal or invalid by reason only of appointment, posting promotion or transfer such made in accordance with the said provisions.".
