An Act further to amend the Constitution of India.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Forty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. Short title.-This Act may be called the Constitution (Seventy-first Amendment) Act, 1992.
- 2. Amendment of Eighth Schedule.-In the Eighth Schedule to the Constitution,-
- (a) existing entry 7 shall be re-numbered as entry 8, and before entry 8 as so re-numbered, the entry "7. Konkani." shall be inserted;
- (b) existing entry 8 shall be re-numbered entry 10. before as and entry 10 re-numbered, "9. Manipuri." shall as so the entry be inserted;
- (c) existing entries 9 15 shall be re-numbered entries 12 18 to as respectively, before 12 "11. and entry as SO re-numbered, the entry Nepali." shall be inserted.
