

**THE MADHYA PRADESH AYURVEDIC, UNANI TATHA PRAKRITIC CHIKITSA
VYAVASAYI (SANSHODHAN) ADHINIYAM, 2016.**

Madhya Pradesh Act
(No. 4 of 2017)

**An Act further to amend the Madhya Pradesh Ayurvedic, Unani Tatha Prakritic Chikitsa
Vyavasayi Adhiniyam, 1970.**

Be it enacted by the Madhya Pradesh Legislature in the Sixty-seventh year of the Republic of
India as follows :—

1. **Short title** - This Act may be called the Madhya Pradesh Ayurvedic, Unani Tatha Prakritic Chikitsa Vyavasayi (Sanshodhan) Adhiniyam, 2016.
2. **Amendment of Section 33** - In Section 33 of the Madhya Pradesh Ayurvedic, Unani Tatha Prakritic Chikitsa Vyavasayi Adhiniyam, 1970 (No. 5 of 1971), in sub-section (4), for full stop, colon shall be substituted and thereafter the following proviso shall be added, namely:—

“Provided that a person possessing a degree in Ayurvedic system or Unani system and registered with the Board and have undergone training specified by the Government, from time to time, and posted in Government sector shall also be eligible to practice modern scientific medicine which is also known as “allopathy” and such other medical procedures to the extent of training, and shall also be eligible to be posted in the Government health institutions or centers of allopathic system of medicine.”.
