MAIN EXAMINATION (WRITTEN)

For Main Examination, the relatively more meritorious candidates from among those who appeared in the Preliminary Examination in the ratio of I: 10 having regard to the number of vacancies shall be called for final Examination to be conducted which shall consist of:
