



## EXAM PATTERN

### KARNATAKA

The Karnataka High Court Civil Judge Exam pattern will guide you through the marking scheme of the exam. The candidates can understand the number of marks allotted to each question and the time given to solve the test. Knowing the marking system will help one to prepare according to the weightage given to each topic or subject. The Exam pattern for all the stages is described in the tables below.

#### Preliminary Exam

This is a qualifying exam to be eligible for the second stage of the exam process, i.e., the Main Exam Round.

The exam is of 100 marks in total.

Candidates who qualify this round will be eligible for the Main Exam Round.
