MP Civil Judge Exam Pattern 2021

The MP Civil Judge exam pattern is different for both the Preliminary and the Mains Examination. The selection for the MP Civil Judge posts is based on three stages, i.e., Screening, Mains, and the Interview round. The Preliminary exams have objective type of questions that carry 150 marks, while the main examination has descriptive types of questions carrying a total of 400 marks. The total number of questions in both these examinations are different as well. The table below provides the detailed MP Civil Judge exam pattern for both the Screening Test and the Main Examination.
