



EXAM PATTERN

PUNJAB

Before having the preparation for prelims and mains exam let's see the structure and exam pattern given below. The preliminary exam is conducted only for the qualifying purpose. You have to get minimum cut-off marks in the mains exam and interview to get your name on the provisional merit list.

Prelims

- The duration of the exam is 2 hours
- Candidates have to answer the questions in a duration of 2 hours for 125 questions.
- The Question paper is of objective type i.e multiple choice type questions.
- Each question carries 4 marks
- The Preliminary exam will be conducted for 500 marks.
- Negative marking is applied to the Punjab Judiciary exam. So, 0.20 marks will be deducted from the actual answer.
