2026 Civil Judge Exam: Law Graduates Can Appear Without Prior Advocacy Practice; 405 Posts to Be Filled

2026 सिविल जज परीक्षा में बिना वकालत के बैठ सकेंगे लॉ ग्रेजुएट, 405 पदों पर भर्ती

मध्यप्रदेश में 2026 की सिविल जज (जूनियर डिवीजन) भर्ती परीक्षा में सभी लॉ ग्रेजुएट बिना वकालत के अनुभव के शामिल हो सकेंगे। इससे करीब 90% लॉ विद्यार्थियों को फायदा मिलेगा और करीब 50 हजार लॉ ग्रेजुएट परीक्षा में शामिल हो सकेंगे।

सुप्रीम कोर्ट के फैसले के बाद वकालत का एक साल का नियम 1 अप्रैल 2027 से लागू होगा। प्रदेश की निबली अदालतों में करीब 405 पद खाली हैं। वर्ष 2023,

2024, 2025 और 2026 के खाली पदों को मिलाकर भर्ती होगी। हाल की 192 पदों की परीक्षा में सिर्फ 47 अभ्यर्थी चुने गए थे। बची 145 सीटें कैसे भरवाई करने के बजाय नए सिरे से परीक्षा में शामिल होंगी।

चयन के बाद दो साल की ट्रेनिंग में आधी सैलरी करीब 70 हजार रुपए मिलेगी। ट्रेनिंग और जांच पकड़ होने के बाद करीब 1.40 लाख रुपए पूरा वेतन और अन्य भत्ते मिलेंगे। ट्रेनिंग में एक साल ज्युडिशियल ट्रेनिंग, छह महीने जिला जज और छह महीने हाईकोर्ट जज के अधीन लॉ क्लर्कशिप होगी।

एक साल वकालत का नियम 3 साल दायल पर

एक साल वकालत का नियम तीन साल पायलट प्रोजेक्ट के तौर पर लागू रहेगा। इसके बाद सुप्रीम कोर्ट रीपोर्ट-नुकसान और जजों की कार्यप्रणाली पर असर की समीक्षा करेगा। जिला जज भर्ती में सात साल की वकालत और 35 से 45 साल उम्र की शर्त रहेगी।

The **2026 Civil Judge (Junior Division) Recruitment Examination in Madhya Pradesh** will allow all law graduates to appear **without any prior experience of legal practice**. This decision will benefit nearly **90% of law students**, and approximately **50,000 law graduates** may become eligible to appear for the examination.

Following the **Supreme Court's decision**, the requirement of **one year of legal practice** will be implemented from **1 April 2027**. There are approximately **405 vacant posts** in the state's lower judiciary.

The recruitment will include vacancies from **2024, 2025 and 2026**. Against **192 posts**, only **47 candidates** had joined the examination earlier. Instead of allowing these vacancies to remain unfilled, the government will now invite fresh applications.

After selection, candidates will undergo **two years of training**. During training, they will receive a stipend of approximately **₹70,000 per month**. After being confirmed in service, they will receive a full salary of approximately **₹1.40 lakh per month**, along with other allowances.

The training will include **one year of judicial training**, followed by **six months of training under a District Judge** and **six months under a High Court Judge**, along with a **Law Clerkship/Legal Workshop**.

One-Year Practice Rule to Be Reviewed After Three Years

The **one-year practice requirement** will be implemented on a **three-year trial basis**. After three years, the **Supreme Court will review its impact on the administration of justice and the functioning of courts**.

For recruitment to the **District Judge** level, the requirement of **seven years of legal practice** will continue, along with an **age requirement of 35 to 45 years**.

Interview

Candidates declared successful in the main examination will be called for interview. The interview will be of **50 marks**. It is mandatory for the candidates to obtain minimum **40 percent marks** in the interview to be finally selected. The decision of the High Court of Madhya Pradesh regarding inviting the candidates for interview will be final. Candidates who remain absent in the interview will be considered ineligible for selection. Candidates will have to produce original/certified copies of all documents at the time of interview.
