



Q. What do you mean by confession and its classification ? Explain in the light of landmark case?

Confession Meaning	Classification of confessions:	Case law
Voluntary admission of the guilt or elements formings the guilt is called confession which is relevant in criminal proceedings.	1. Judicial Confession- made before a magistrate or court during criminal proceedings.	Palvinder Kaur V. State of Punjab A confession must be either admitted on the whole or rejected on whole in evidence.
The confession must be considered as a whole, it is not permissible to enter inculpatory part and reject exculpatory part.	2. Extra-Judicial Confession- made before any person or group of persons otherwise than before magistrate or court.	
	3. Retracted confession- if after making the confession, the accused later on withdraws or denies his previous confession it may be used against him by supporting other reliable evidence.
