Caveat Emptor

CAVEAT EMPTOR.

- Caveat Emptor is a fundamental principle of the law of sale of goods.
- It means "Caution Buyer", i.e. "Let the buyer beware".
- Caveat means "beware".
- Emptor means "buyer".
- In other words, it is not the duty of the seller's to point out defects of his own goods.
- The buyer must inspect the goods to find out if they will suit his purpose.





Antonyms: overprotective, prudent, absorbed, concerned.




